SESSION SYNOPSIS OF AUGUST 18, 2021

Another long but fruitful Session meeting covered MANY topics of importance to FPCV. These can be divided into three main categories: (1) Motions approved; (2) Informational Items; and (3) Praises/Joys/Prayers/Concerns.

Motions:

- 1. Congregational Life:
 - A. There will be a T-shirt fundraiser for the congregation. Samples should be available soon with orders due by September 20.
 - B. There will be a Christmas Craft Fair at FPCV on November 20, 2021, from 8:00AM 4:00PM in the Fellowship Hall. More info later.
- 2. Building & Grounds:
 - A. A cement sidewalk will be installed joining the east side of the Pavilion entry to the adjacent asphalt parking lot.
 - B. A cement pad adjacent to the west parking lot will allow for the construction of a visual and securable enclosure for the trash dumpster.
 - C. FPCV will be sponsoring the Sweet Adelines Chorale Group, Great Lakes Chapter. They will have weekly practices and rehearsals and will also have several small community fundraising events with proceeds being shared between FPCV and the Sweet Adelines.
- 3. Worship
 - A. We will remain worshiping outside in the Pavilion in light of the increased infection rate of COVID and the Delta variant. The only exception is when the weather does not allow it. (This issue will be revisited in September to determine the status for October.)
 - B. If/when we must move inside, we ask for masks to be worn for the same consideration and to keep people safe and healthy.
- 4. Session
 - A. Session has called for the Fall Meeting of the Congregation on Sunday, October 3, 2021, following the 10:00AM Worship service. The agenda has been set and will be communicated to the congregation according to our Bylaws approximately two weeks prior to the meeting.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:

- 1. Congregational Nominating Committee announced names of officer candidates to be elected at the Fall Congregational Meeting on Oct. 3, 2021:
 - A. Elder-nominees for the Class of 2024 are Linda Long, Karen Mitseff, Elizabeth Monroe, and Ron Phillips.
 - B. Deacon-nominees for the Class of 2024 are Joy Dirks, Sharon Harris, June Olling, and Betty Richardson.
 - C. Youth Deacon Nominees for the Class of 2022 are Bella Wunderlin and Maddie Wunderlin.
- 2. Finance Moderator Lisa Pavlopoulos instructed Elders in creating a budget. She explained how to read each team's numbers printout; how to look at the actual expenditures; how to include what is realistic; how to question what is "wonky;" and also asked teams to include any "dream" projects/costs that could be concluded within the one-year budget timeframe.

- 3. Elder liaisons gave updates on the ministry candidates under our care:
 - A. Bill Rogers is no longer under our care as he has been officially ordained and is now a Minister of the Word and Sacrament.
 - B. Director of CE & Youth Minister Ken Crews has completed his studies and is currently working to complete his Professional Information Form (PIF).
 - C. Ron Phillips has graduated from a Commissioned Ruling Elder (CRE) program.
 - D. Tim Reyna has decided to withdraw from the ordination process at this time.
- 4. Unfortunately, the church building has been having problems with the fresh water galvanized pipes within the facility; they are in dire need of repair due to rust accumulation. This issue is being studied for possible solutions.
- 5. PADS Ministry will begin in mid-October with a few changes. The program will now be co-ed, so two separate rooms will be used for sleeping; two sets of overnight volunteers will therefore be needed (male and female). New Creation will be helping with overnight staffing, but volunteers are still essential. Most policies and procedures will remain the same, but masking will probably be required of both clients and volunteers. Beth Germann will coordinate dinner and breakfast schedules and Ryne Press will coordinate all other aspects. Everyone is encouraged to participate in this important and worthwhile ministry by volunteering at least once!

PRAISES/JOYS/PRAYERS/CONCERNS:

- 1. Prayers have been lifted for all who are returning to school in any capacity: students, teachers, administrators, support staff, parents.
- 2. Prayers go out to those struggling with vaccine and mask decisions.
- 3. Prayers are offered for doctors, nurses, and medical support staff.
- 4. Hilltop Neighborhood House does amazing things for children in our wider community, but there are ways in which we can help better prepare the kids for the start of school by providing supplies in a timely manner. Future project!
- 5. Sometimes connecting with a worship experience isn't always easy depending on what individuals are facing in their everyday lives; we all need to be mindful of and sensitive to the needs and feelings of others.
- 6. Congratulations to the first female Eagle Scout in the history of our church! A Court of Honor was held in our Pavilion on August 21 for Kaily Van Wienen.
- 7. There have been many positive comments and lots of good conversation around the summer concert series and the upcoming sermon series on joy!
- 8. Praises and special gratitude should be extended to the Building & Grounds team and moderators Rick Exley and Vic Klancer who have been spending SO much time keeping our facility working as well as possible (as well as the awesome work of Dan Higgins and Val Smart Higgins!).
- 9. Long overdue thank you's are finally going to the many members who have been both generous and faithful in supporting the ministries of FPCV despite the struggles of the past year and a half.
- 10. Prayers have been requested for elders, relatives of elders, and congregation members who are undergoing surgeries, testing, treatment, and recovery.

THE EAGLE RISES

On August 21, the family and friends of Kaily Van Wienen gathered in the FPC pavilion to celebrate Kaily's achievement of the Eagle Scout rank. Kaily recently completed a ten-day backpacking trek at the Scout's premier High Adventure Camp, the Philmont Scout Ranch in New Mexico. She is currently planning to pursue a nursing career, like her mom, Scoutmaster Mary Van Wienen.
