PRESCHOOL PLANNING TEAM UPDATE

After being created by Session to explore options as to how our church might serve children and families in our community, the Preschool Planning Team has been meeting almost every other Tuesday afternoon since February. To date, a set of Policies & Procedures has been created and approved by Session along with job descriptions for our Preschool staff. The Planning Team has worked collaboratively with the existing Preschool Leadership Team which will be changed to the Preschool Governance Team (AKA Preschool Team) which will be comprised of the Faith Formation Moderator + one nominee from the Faith Formation Team, two nominees from the Mission Team, two At-Large members nominated by the existing Preschool Leadership Team and one parent or grandparent of a Preschool Student. The Preschool Team member terms will be staggered to provide continuity over time. The slate of nominees will be put forth for Session approval at the August Session Meeting. Once in place, the Preschool Team will be responsible for the operations of the Preschool and the implementation of Session-approved policies and strategies.

The Sharing Table Project identified our Preschool as one of the first five priorities, so the Preschool Planning Team is now turning its attention to exploring the longer-term options for how our church can impact the families in our community. Some additional offerings through the Preschool and possibly some options for meeting daycare needs of working families will be included in their work. Members of the Preschool Planning Team are: Cathy Cole, Cathy Greenawald, Karen Hahn (Bloomington), Doug Hollar, Jim Hubbard, Harry Karabel, Paul Knauff and Lisa Pavlopoulos.

Dana who has been our part-time Preschool Director since early 2023 is moving onto a new role at an elementary school; and a search is underway for her replacement.

The recruiting document for this part-time Preschool Director is now posted on the church website and on the Presbyterian Preschool website. The Personnel Team will receive the information from interested individuals and follow its normal processes in screening and interviewing candidates.

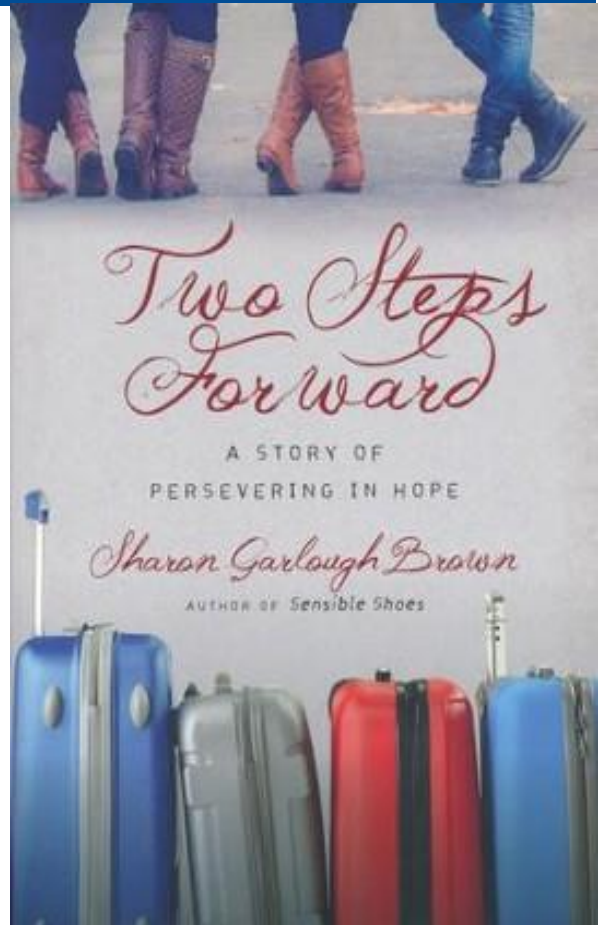

PLANNED GIVING

DO YOU HAVE A WILL?

Do you have a Will? That's a question Connie and I asked ourselves as a young couple in our 20's. The answer was No. Why did we need a Will? We were relatively young, in good health, and did not see the need at the time. Life changes, however. When our oldest daughter was born in 1974, we began to think differently. How would she be provided for if we were not available to do so? Our thinking changed, and we had a Will written primarily for the purpose of providing guardianship for our children.

Seventy percent of adult Americans do not have Wills. A carefully written one has many benefits. A Will can conserve your estate, expedite settlement, and creatively care for those you love. A Will can also provide an avenue for you to support those charities and non-profits that you have passionately supported during your lifetime. Your church is an example that you can support forever through a Will.

So now Connie and I are in our 70's, and our children are adults providing for themselves. We made the decision that it was time to update our Will. This time we chose an Estate plan for the present and future. An Estate plan is a written expression of one's intentions for the protection and preservation of your assets during your lifetime and their management and distribution upon one's passing.

A Will is a cornerstone, but an Estate plan covers guardianship as well as power of attorney for financial decisions if you can no longer make those, a healthcare proxy with the responsibility for making medical decisions, and sometimes a living will directive which may eliminate a difficult decision for your loved ones.

The question again is, Do you have a Will? It is never too early or too late to have one written.

CHRISTIAN FOOD PANTRY

The Christian Food Pantry served one hundred sixty-one families in June providing food for four hundred thirty-six. One hundred thirty-six Kid's Kits were distributed. The extra donations for the Kid's Kits have been generous and will still be needed for two weeks in August.

Fruit cups and drinks are usually needed the most. Already some donations have been received from local gardeners and the fresh veggies are always appreciated.

Regularly fresh fruits along with other perishable items are purchased with the gifts given to the pantry. Laundry and dish soaps are regularly needed along with tissues (allergy season) and paper towels. Toilet paper is given with each bag of food so that donations are always needed.

If you use it, others need it, too. This phrase covers the items needed for helping families coming to the pantry for assistance.
