

RECENT GIFTS

With sincere gratitude on behalf of our congregation, we are pleased to announce receipt of a loving bequest from the Estate of Marcelle Johnson. The bequest is an undesignated cash gift with no restrictions and so may be designated as Session determines appropriate. Many in our congregation knew Marcelle, who was a member of First Presbyterian since April 1, 1945, just shy of eighty years. She loved her church and enjoyed contributing in a variety of ways. Marcelle celebrated her 100th birthday in our Friendship Room in 2023. We appreciate her remembrance of our congregation through this bequest and are deeply grateful for her life and steadfast connection to her faith and First Presbyterian throughout these many years.

Informed Giving - Donating Stocks, Bonds, Mutual Funds, or ETF's

If I have stocks, bonds, or mutual funds, does it make any difference whether I:

- A. Transfer them directly to the church or
- B. Sell them and write a check to the church?

Yes, it makes a difference to you, because:

A. If the stock, bond, etc. is <u>worth more</u> than you paid for it or the value is now more than when you received it as a gift or inheritance, you should <u>definitely have your broker transfer the stock directly to the church's brokerage</u> account. This way you do not pay any capital gains tax (about 20%) on the amount of your gain.

Example: 10 years ago, John bought 100 shares of XYZ stock for \$10 a share. He sells it for \$30. \$3,000 - \$1,000 = a \$2,000 capital gain which results in about \$400 in capital gains taxes.

If he transfers the stock directly to the church, he does not owe the \$400.

If he sells the stock himself and then writes a check to the church, he will have to pay about \$400 more in taxes.

(Contact the church office to get the church brokerage account information you will need for the transfer.)

B. If the stock, bond, etc. is worth less than when you bought or received it, sell it yourself and then write a check to the church. This way, you can deduct the amount of your capital loss as specified in the tax law.

Example: 10 years ago, John bought 100 shares of XYZ stock for \$30 a share. He sells it for only \$10 a share. \$3,000 - \$1,000 = \$2,000 John has a \$2,000 loss he can use to reduce his taxes, but only if he sells the shares and writes a check to the church.

So, 1 - if you have <u>a gain</u> on the investment, <u>have it transferred</u> directly to the church, but 2 - if you have <u>a loss</u>, <u>sell it yourself</u> and write a check.

PADS MINISTRY INFORMATION VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

FPCV hosts PADS on Wednesday evening 6:00 PM through Thursday morning 7:00 AM through April 9, 2025.

PADS is a nonprofit organization dedicated to providing emergency shelter for men in our community. PADS offers a comprehensive approach to combating homelessness with the compassion and respect all deserve.

FPCV is transformed each Wednesday so that we can serve dinner that evening, provide a warm and comfortable place to sleep, and serve breakfast on Thursday morning. Last year we averaged 8-12 men per week.

PADS is for men only, who are in the program at New Creation to help them find jobs and housing so that they no longer need to be part of the PADS program. In the past years many men have succeeded in finding jobs and housing. We celebrate them!

FPCV is a cooperative effort with other area congregations and the community in general. Anyone can volunteer to help. A volunteer form needs to be completed. St Andrews Church and Trinity Lutheran Church help FPCV with volunteers, dinners, bedding and supplies.

CONGREGATIONAL FINANCIAL REPORT AS OF OCTOBER 15, 2024

Each week we catch glimpses of daily congregational life as our living witness as Christ's church. In worship, ministry teams, faith formation classes, PADS program providing food and shelter for men experiencing homelessness, our preschool, our thriving resale shop, session meetings...we walk our pathway of discipleship. Our collective generosity makes investing in these visible ministries possible.

- So far this year, we have contributed \$383,459 as pledged gifts, general giving, loose offerings and per capita contributions for our <u>operations</u>.
- We have received \$10,159 in building use fees, interest income, miscellaneous income and planned gifts of \$59,814 with \$53,000 of that set aside as reserve funds in interest-bearing CDs.
- Not counting the unanticipated estate gift, we received \$393,618 toward our budget, or nearly 75% during the first ³/₄ of this year.
- ◆ Total general income as of October 15th is \$453,432 toward 2024 budgeted income of \$532,760
- Our operating expenses to date for personnel, building costs and ministry teams total \$428,795
- Our 2024 patterns of giving are honoring the commitments made a year ago to fund our vibrant ministries!
- Currently there are 59 pledges toward annual operating funds, which total \$324,824, as we begin budget planning for 2025.

Beyond operating fund pledges, our <u>discretionary giving</u> so far this year for 2nd Mile and other mission opportunities "outside our walls" exceeds \$49,000, supplemented by designated distributions from our Endowment Fund of \$18,980 for a total income designated for specific missions and ministries at over \$68,065.

Plus, there are gifts to The Sharing Table Project dedicated to visionary missions and ministries plus upgrades to our facilities that total \$186,718 this year to date. Total Sharing Table contributions about halfway through three -year pledge period total \$505,901 of our collective commitment for \$795,301. These gifts have already allowed us to install solar panels on the education wing roof, upgrade our live streaming equipment for worship, initiate the *Godly Play* program for our children, and contract for consulting services to specify "green energy" HVAC to replace our aging boiler system. Sharing Table funds are invested in interest-bearing accounts.

Then there are the self-sustaining ministries of our <u>Presbyterian Church Resale Shop</u> and our <u>Presbyterian Preschool</u> that serve our local community. Our Shop and its cadre of 45+ volunteers have generated \$63,636 in sales as of October 15th and distributed more than \$27,000 to missions aligned with our Matthew 25 goals. Our preschool is serving 28 students in its Early Learners (7) and Pre-K (21) classes. Tuition of \$34,620 and designated gifts of \$8,265 exceed its expenses and scholarships of \$33,855 to date.

Our congregation's generosity strengthens the financial foundations of ministry for the future. We are richly blessed with this foundation as we trust in the grace of God and the blessings of the Spirit and continue to envision and address the needs of ministry and outreach to others in 2024.
