NURTURING “THE JOY OF GIVING”



When I was young, I spent a lot of time before my birthday and Christmas thinking about what I wanted and anticipating what I would receive: a toy gas station, a baseball mitt, a transistor radio... **RECEIVING** gifts brought me great joy! I gradually discovered that **GIVING** gifts to my wife, children, parents and sharing in their joy could also bring me great joy.

However, giving “joyfully” to those beyond family and close friends is a giant step beyond self-interest that many are never able to take. Some give, but out of a feeling of obligation, not joy, and many don’t give at all.

Positive life experiences have helped some of us to cultivate a joyful heart for giving; parents who modeled joyful giving, having been a recipient of joyful giving, an “AHA” awakening, etc.

We can also **intentionally** cultivate our hearts for joyful giving and embrace generosity as a spiritual practice. Here are some ways we can nurture joy in giving:

1. Recognize Giving as Worship

Giving is an act of worship that reflects gratitude for God’s blessings. When you see it as a way to honor Him, it becomes a joyful expression rather than an obligation.

2. Start with Gratitude

A heart overflowing with gratitude naturally leads to generosity. Reflect on the ways God has provided for you and let that gratitude inspire your giving.

3. Give Cheerfully and Willingly

The Bible encourages giving with a joyful heart: *“Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver”* (2 Corinthians 9:7). When giving is done willingly, it brings fulfillment rather than stress.

4. Focus on the Impact

Seeing how your contributions help others—whether supporting ministries, aiding those in need, or strengthening the church—can deepen your joy in giving.

5. Trust in God’s Provision

Generosity builds faith. Malachi 3:10 reminds us that God blesses those who give faithfully. Trusting that He will provide allows you to give with confidence.

6. Make Giving a Habit

Incorporate generosity into your daily life. Whether through financial gifts, acts of service, or words of encouragement, consistently giving fosters a joyful heart.

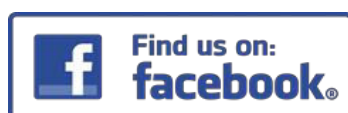
