Dear Beloved Community,

In August, we both began and concluded our worship series, *The Justice Jukebox*, exploring God's call to justice through scripture, song, and story. We also launched a new members class that will wrap up on September 7. With school back in session and gardens yielding their harvest, the seasons are shifting—and so is the cadence of our shared life together.

Back in June, Jeff and I had the joy of traveling with several members of our congregation to the Worship and Music Conference at Montreat. This year's theme, "Clothed in Love," was inspired by Colossians 3:12–17 (NRSVue):

"As God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience. Bear with one another and, if anyone has a complaint against another, forgive each other; just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in the one body. And be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly; teach and admonish one another in all wisdom; and with gratitude in your hearts sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs to God. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him."

Throughout the week, we experienced these words come alive, not just in the beauty of music and worship, but in the stories of scripture. We revisited familiar ones, like the Good Samaritan and Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, and discovered new depths in lesser-known stories of Abigail, Naaman, and the persistent unnamed widow from one of Jesus' parables. Together, we explored what it means to "try on" compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, and then "pack them in our bags" to bring home. Montreat is a rich experience for all ages, and if you are interested in joining us next year, we'd love to have you. There is truly something for everyone, and it's a beautiful way to connect with Christians from across the country and creation.

As we move into September, our shared calendar is full of opportunities for worship, fellowship, learning, and service. On Sunday, September 7, we hope to welcome new members during worship. That day is also Rally Day and our church picnic—please bring a dish to share! It will be a wonderful time to reconnect after the summer and hear about the upcoming year of Sunday morning Faith Formation for all ages.

On Saturday, September 13, from 10:00 AM—4:00 PM, Women at the Well will host their second all day retreat in the Friendship Room called Pathway to Prayer where the participants will explore different ways to pray. Participants can register to TLawason@fpcvalpo.org by September 5.

On Sunday, September 14, we will celebrate Creation Care Sunday in worship, followed by a light lunch and a viewing of the film *Plastic Wars*, with discussion to follow. The Mission Team is eager to deepen our commitment to environmental ministry. Last year we celebrated the installation of solar panels; this year, we turn our attention to how we might reduce our use of plastics as part of our stewardship of creation.

If music stirs your heart, keep an eye out for opportunities to join our music ministry in the months ahead. Whether in song, service, or study, there is a place for you here.

As we begin this new program year, may you be clothed in love, filled with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience. May the peace of Christ dwell richly in you, binding us together in the love of God and neighbor.

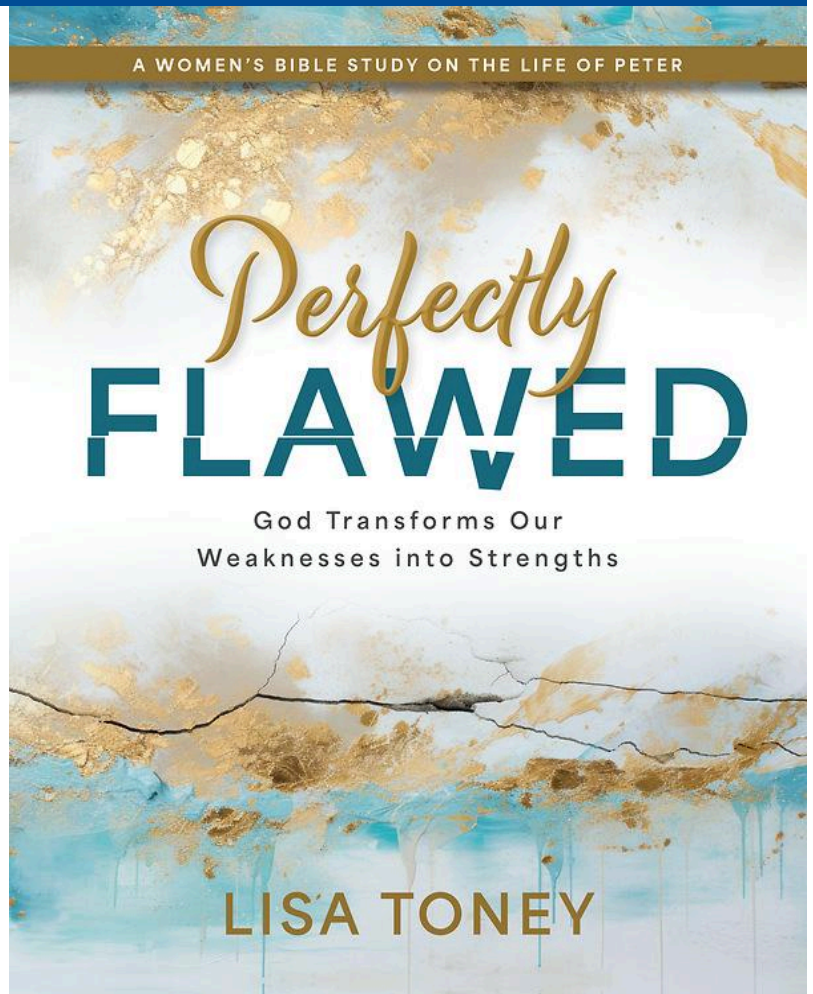

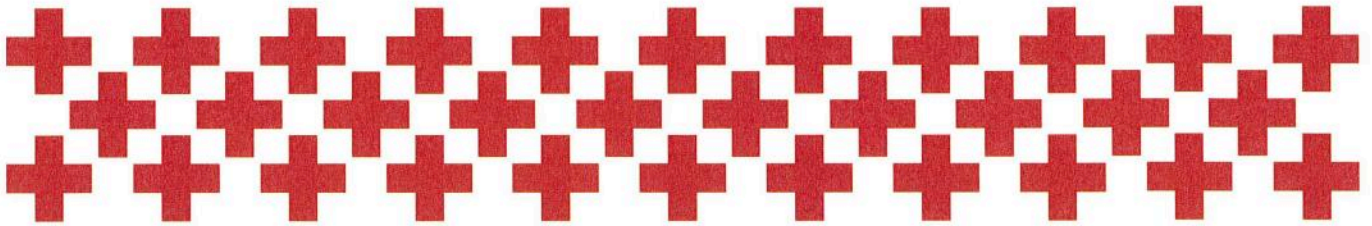

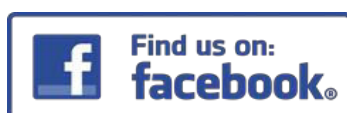
